



DOWNING COLLEGE CAMBRIDGE

GLYNN JONES SCHOLARSHIPS *(For Business and Management Education)*

The Governing Body invites applications for a Glynn Jones Scholarship to fund the cost or part-cost of a course at Cambridge University or other institution in this country or abroad of not more than two years' duration in the field of business and management.

The type of course normally considered for a Scholarship is one which will help equip applicants for a successful career in management or business and will usually be a specifically designed management training course leading to the MBA or a qualification of equivalent standing. Please note however, applications for a one or two year postgraduate course with a high management or business training content will also be considered for a Scholarship.

The value of a Scholarship will be determined by the course fees, travel costs and maintenance expenses associated with the course for which the Scholarship is awarded. The financial resources of the applicant will also be taken into consideration, as well as any other scholarships or bursaries awarded, applications pending, or funds which the applicant may also be eligible to apply.

The number of scholarships offered in any given year will not exceed that which can be funded from the annual income of the fund.

Applicants will have fulfilled the requirements of an undergraduate or postgraduate degree at Cambridge University as members of Downing College by the start date of the course for which the award is to be made.

Scholarship applications for a course beginning not earlier than the September of any given calendar year must be received not later than 2 June of that calendar year, although later applications may sometimes be considered if sufficient funds remain unallocated.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The online process requires the completion of a personal and academic record section, a brief questionnaire and upload of a one page CV by 12.00 noon on **Friday 2 June 2017**. In addition, the names of two senior persons acquainted with the candidate's academic work (one of whom must be or has been the candidate's supervisor) should be provided.
