

Are you protected **against** preventable infectious diseases?

Before you come to Cambridge, check whether you have received the required vaccinations or need a TB test:

Meningitis (MenACWY)

All students are strongly advised to have the MenACWY conjugate vaccine before arriving.

Mumps, Measles and Rubella (MMR)

All students are strongly advised to have two doses of the MMR vaccination before arriving.

International students arriving from certain countries will be required to undertake a TB test as part of their visa application.
