SUNDAYS DURING FULL TERM

A quiet, reflective service using the traditional liturgy of the Book of Common Prayer, largely unchanged since 1552. For 2000 years, most Christians have placed the weekly celebration of communion at the heart of their spiritual life together.

A close look at a very encouraging New Testament text with an amazing breadth of vision.
