THE HOWARD FOUNDATION POSTGRADUATE TRAVEL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Howard Foundation Travel Scholarships are open to all postgraduate students in STEM subjects currently matriculated at Downing College to advance their research and foster collaboration internationally. Scholarships are intended to contribute towards the cost of national and international travel to academic conferences, meetings and to related academic institutions within the UK, Ireland and internationally.

Scholarships will be offered up to a maximum of £2,000 per student and will be assessed according to financial need, as well as the benefit to the individual student's academic research. Applicants are required to demonstrate that other sources of financial support are not sufficient to cover their costs. Costs supported can include travel to a conference, accommodation, and registration fees. Students are eligible for one scholarship only for the duration of their time at Downing College.

Successful applicants are required to write a report for the donors which should be submitted to the [Tutorial and Admissions Office](#) on their return. In the case that no students meet the criteria, no scholarships will be offered in a particular year.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made [online](#). The online process requires the completion of a personal, academic record and questionnaire section. In addition, the name of the Supervisor and Postgraduate College Tutor should be provided by the deadline advertised on the College website.
