THE JOHN WHITWORTH STUDENTSHIP IN NATURAL SCIENCES OR GEOGRAPHY

The Governing Body invites applications for the John Whitworth Studentship in Natural Sciences or Geography. This Studentship is supported by the Whitworth Fund established in memory of John N Whitworth (1949) and his achievements. John N Whitworth, who died in 2013, studied and took a Certificate of Education at Downing.

One fully-funded* Studentship to commence next academic year is offered by Downing College. The value of a Studentship will be determined by the University and College composition fees for the course for which the Studentship is to be awarded and a maintenance allowance which is determined annually by the Electors according to amounts recommended by the UK research councils. The financial resources of the applicant will also be taken into consideration, as well as any other scholarships or bursaries awarded, applications pending, or funds to which the applicant may also be eligible to apply.

* Please note, this Studentship will be funded to the level of home fees only. A partial award will be made should overseas fees apply.

Applicants must have fulfilled the requirements of a degree at Cambridge University as members of Downing College by the start date of the course for which the award is to be made.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made [online](#). The online process requires the completion of a personal and academic record section, a brief questionnaire, upload of a one page CV, statement of research (not exceeding 600 words) and one piece of academic writing (not exceeding 3000 words). In addition, the names of two senior persons acquainted with the applicant's academic work should be provided by the deadline advertised on the College website.
