OON KHYE BENG CH'HIA TSIO AND PERCY LANDER STUDENTSHIPS FOR RESEARCH IN PREVENTATIVE MEDICINE

(Students in the fields of Medicine and Biological Sciences are encouraged to apply)

At least one Studentship worth £2,000 [Oon] or £1,500 [Percy Lander] a year, tenable for up to two years, subject to a satisfactory annual report by the recipient and a further specific research or training need for funding, for research in preventative medicine is offered by Downing College.

TREHERNE STUDENTSHIP IN BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES

The Governing Body invites applications for a Treherne Studentship in Biological Sciences. This Studentship is supported by the John Treherne Fund established in memory of John Treherne and his achievements. Dr Treherne, who died in 1989, was a Fellow and President of Downing College.

At least one Studentship worth £1,500 a year, tenable for up to two years, subject to a satisfactory annual report by the recipient and a further specific research or training need for funding, is offered by Downing College.

Candidates for all three Studentships must be registered for the PhD Degree in the University of Cambridge as a member of Downing College and should be entering the 2nd or 3rd year of their PhD studies. Please note however that these awards are not intended to fund the writing up of theses or unfunded 4th or 5th years. No student may hold or have held at any time both a Treherne Studentship and an Oon Khye Beng Ch'Hia Tsio or Lander Studentship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made [online](#). The online process requires the completion of a personal and academic record section, a brief questionnaire and upload of a one page CV and statement of research (not exceeding 600 words). Applicants should indicate how they intend to spend the award on their research (for example, supplementary training or research placement). Additionally, the names of two senior persons acquainted with the candidate's academic work (one of whom must be the candidate's research supervisor) should be provided by the deadline advertised on the College website.
