SUNDAYS DURING FULL TERM

11.30 am Holy Communion

A quiet, reflective service using the traditional liturgy of the Book of Common Prayer, largely unchanged since 1552. For 2000 years, most Christians have placed the weekly celebration of communion at the heart of their spiritual life together.

12.00 pm Chapel Lunch

Free pizza for Downing members who attend any other Chapel activities during the day.

12.30 pm The Bible in a Term

A talk by the Chaplain, followed by time for questions and discussion, exploring each of the main sections of the world's most famous and influential book.

6.00 pm Choral Evensong

Experience one of the most beautiful Cambridge traditions, with inspiring words and music from many centuries sung by our talented choir in the candlelit Chapel. The service lasts about 45 minutes and is followed by free sherry and orange juice. We encourage members of Downing to wear their gowns. Choral Evensong takes place most Sundays, with these variations:

Evensong on 9 October is in memory of Queen Elizabeth II.

No Evensong on 13 November; the Choir sings instead at the Act of Remembrance at 10.55 am.

The very popular Advent Carol Service takes place on 27 November at 6 pm.
